Time required for coordinating and marking large or complex submissions	Break down the assessment into manageable sections Limit the size of submissions Use grading rubrics with clear assessment criteria Align a single assessment with several learning outcomes
Maintaining grading consistency and validity	Use grading rubrics with clear assessment criteria Incorporate multiple sources of evidence
Learners unfamiliar with task or lack skills to complete it	Use scaffolding strategies Provide clear instructions and links to supporting resources
Large class sizes	Include self-assessment and peer assessment Leverage peer review and peer feedback Assign as group work
Academic Integrity	Compare completed assignments to earlier drafts and revisions Require “construct”-type responses Personalize the tasks
