
Equality, Equity, and Justice panels



A four-panel image depicting three individuals of three different heights and their attempts to view a baseball game from behind a fence.

- In the first panel, the three individuals are each standing on one crate. However, the first individual is very tall and sees over the fence; likewise the second individual is of medium height and can also peek over the fence. The last individual cannot see over the fence, even though they are standing on one crate. The label on the panel says 'Equality.'
- In the second panel, the crates have shifted position such that the tallest individual no longer has a crate as they can easily see over the fence, and this crate is now helping the shortest individual see over the fence. The medium height individual retains their one crate. The label on the panel says 'Equity.'
- In the third panel, all the individuals can see the game as the fence has been removed so no crates are needed. The label on the panel says 'Justice.'
- The fourth panel is completely blank. The label on the panel says 'Your idea here.'
