

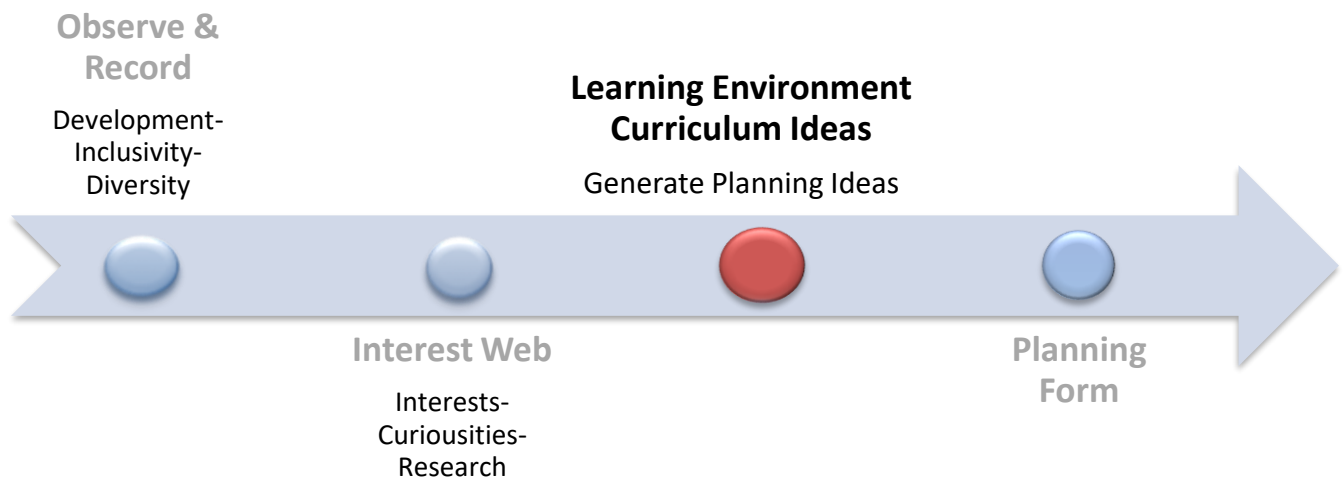


## Learning Environment Curriculum Ideas

This document is a guide for brainstorming ideas for learning areas and experiences using the interest(s) or inquiries determined in your interest webbing.

### Format

Students may choose to brainstorm using paper and pen/coloured pencils or using a web-based program. Students must check for acceptable submission format in each class/placement.



### Process

- Consider all areas of development, inclusivity and diversity.
- The following learning areas may be included when brainstorming: sensory, shelf toys, music, creative art, dramatic play, library & listening, blocks, science, math, writing/literacy, computers/technology, woodworking, (other). Check placement and course requirements.
- Small and large group experiences should be included.
