Page 1 In the presence of Lambert Micoin Royal Notary In Louisbourg Isle Royale was present Pierre Ruette Dauteuil esquire, Sr de lamalottière Captain and owner of the St Pierre schooner present in this port, which has hereby voluntarily ceded and returned purely & simply with promises of guarantees, to Sr Jean Seigneur innkeeper of this present city and accepting for his ??? and assignee namely that the Sr de lamalottiere transfers to him the right of mistress (?) he has over a sauvage Panis named Louise about twenty-five years old who was brought up as a slave in Canada, this Nation being subject to slavery, as it is the use in the said country of Canada The said Louise was handed over to the said Sr De lamalottière in Montreal by the said Sr Louis Mave??? of the said town for the master of the said Louise the Sr De lamalottiere

Page 2 to dispose of by the said Sr De lamalottière as he (wants)?, by means of which he has now handed over to the said Sr. Seigneur the said Louise to serve him in the said capacity of slave and for him to dispose of as he will see good, in recognition the said Sr Seigneur gave to the said De lamalottiere two barrels of red wine from ???? and promises and obliges himself to give him next year at his requisition and as soon as the vessels of France arrive at this port other two barrels of red wine ??? or Bordeaux without distinction. The Sr Seigneur promises to have Good care of the said Louise like a good master & to maintain her as long as she is at his service in fear of God and in the Apostolic and Roman Catholic religion that she professes, and that he will give her what will be necessary for her sustenance & clothing according to her condition. The parties agreed that in the case of

Page 3	any opposition to the said Seigneur using and disposing of the said Louise as his slave either by the authority of the Mess. Governor or the <i>ardonateur</i> of the colony, or that it would be contrary to Her Majesty's intentions in which case the said Sieur De lamalottiere undertakes to render to the said Seigneur in this city four barrels of wine of the quality of those mentioned above by the said S. Seigneur giving him back the said Louise, would even be able in this case to send her back to Canada on account and risk of said Sr De lamalottiere, and demand eturn -???????- of the wine he had given. Thus has been agreed upon and settled between the parties in Louisbourg, Isle Royale at the study of the undersigned notary on the afternoon of the twentieth day of August Seventeen hundred twenty seven in the presence of Claude Joseph Demarest ??? in this town and of Sr. Matignon Larregny merchant of present (?) in this town, requested witnesses who have signed with the parties . # ??? the said Sr. Lamalottiere will be submitted to the guarantee mentioned above
