

Sr de Thury missionary Chibouctou xi october

He managed to retain most of the *Sauvages* of the Peninsula of l'acadie and offered them to assemble all in one location of this peninsula that they chose together and they promised him that they would go there next spring

By this means we will be able to instruct them and turn them into Christians, this will also ensure this part of l'acadie against enemy attacks, as all these *sawages* could storm at the right time on those who would dare.

but for that he asks some help namely 400 tools for clearing the ground, two dozen sickles, Two dozen tranches fifty lines for cod 200 hooks for cod 2. at 300 Axes. 6 barrels of salt 2. barrels of corn From the last harvest. 2 Barrels of large bean a barrel of white peas It is necessary

to give them also two big boats for the maintenance of which they will be responsible for these not only will they assist the french established along the coast; but they will even guard against Foreigners It will also be necessary that I have 3 Ecclesiastics at this mission. 2 to go with Sauvages who will separate into two bands to go hunting and the other to stay in the village with the elderly, women and children. It takes 500 L for each of these ecclesiastics to be able to survive

Through the exercise of Religion it is necessary to build them a church that will cost 6000 L not to mention the wood, the plaster and many other things that we will find on the spot
