



1. Brainstorm a List of Collaborators

Identify collaborators that could be impacted by your project idea.



2. Prioritize Your Collaborators

Indicate who you think would have the greatest personal interest in the project/issue you identified.



3. Seek to Understand Primary Collaborators

Select who you consider to be the primary and secondary collaborators in your list.



4. Consider Your Relationship to Primary Collaborators

Indicate whether you are or are not personally connected in some way to each group.



5. Becoming an Ally

Identify two or three people who are primary collaborators and understand their perspectives.
