Course Links

In this video, I'll show you how I use course links to make navigating through my course as intuitive as possible.

Here is my home page, and the most recent item is an update about the final quiz. Inside this update is a hyperlink that takes students directly to the final quiz folder. This makes it really easy for a student to find.

This information is also in my "Assignments" section. So a student can find the final quiz either by going to the "Assignments" section, as they've done all semester, or after reading my update on the course home page. Both methods work.

In addition, if we go into the Weekly Learning Content for Week 2, there is an assignment below all the lessons and activities. Students who work their way through the folder will then be able to access the assignment right here.

That assignment is also posted in the "Assignments" section.

This makes it really simple for a student to find what they need. Items are grouped qualitatively (so, all assignments are together) and also chronologically (all items grouped together by week).

These sorts of pathways allow a student to find the material that they need easily, without having to click around the course too much.
