WebAdvisor – How to find your Class List

Quick Reference Guide



WebAdvisor

WebAdvisor is the place where you can find all of your official information, including you official class list.

Your class list will change repeatedly within the first 10 days of term as students get settled into their courses. If you have any questions, connect with your Educational Support Technologist, Program Manager, or Academic Planner.

Class List

WebAdvisor should be used as the most accurate source of information. FOL updates at a set point every day and does not have up to the minute information.

A few days after the add/drop deadline (first 10 days of class) alert your Educational Support Technologist if the two lists do not match.

*Note: Different sections in the same course (PT/CE) appear separately on WebAdvisor but together on FOL.

Finding your Class List on WebAdvisor

- Login to WebAdvisor (use your regular Fanshawe Credentials)
- WebAdvisor
- Click on the WebAdvisor for Faculty menu option

Directly:

Through myFanshawe:

WebAdvisor is in the list on the right called "Links"

- Access myFanshawe on any college computer by opening up Internet Explorer or using the myFanshawe icon on your desktop
