Conditions of Admission

- This offer of admission is conditional upon successful completion of your current studies with an average of 70% or better, and receipt of your final transcript. Please note, in order to register at Trent, this information must be received in the Office of the Registrar as soon as possible.

Nurses and nursing students deal with patients/clients who have low immune system functioning or may have infectious diseases. To protect nursing students and patients from harm, all students must meet non-academic requirements (NARS) to be registered in and enter clinical practice. Your NARs are updated on an ongoing basis while enrolled in the program. Annual certifications and renewals include TB testing, CPR, and Vulnerable Sector Screening police check. Biannual certifications and renewal are N95 mask fit testing and chest X-ray for those who cannot complete TB testing.

NARs for first-year students also include completing the Communicable disease form, proof of COVID-19 vaccination and boosters, IPAC modules, and additional in-house documentation. The deadline for NARs first-year completion and verification with Synergy Verified is November 15, 2024.

We strongly recommend you meet with your primary care provider (physician, NP) to complete the Immunization and Communicable Disease Form and have your TB test done during the summer before you come to Trent. Applicants that accept an offer of admission will receive detailed instructions about submitting their NARs at the summer orientation.
