Finger Manipulation, Reading, Co-ordination, Plectrum Practice: on the "G" String

(continue with combination fingering although only the one finger is shown)

Read the notes and recognize the inflection. i.e. "Ab" is an "A" but a different colour. In "talking" your way through the exercises, call the "Ab" an "A" but recognize its inflection. Calling it an "A flat" takes up too much time and also involves two syllables which can throw you off rhythm.

Yes, these exercises are similar to what you have done before but they are not necessarily the same. If you are just playing the pattern, you may be fooling yourself into thinking that you are learning.
