
## (Book 4) Lesson 19a. Notes on the "E" (6th) String

Alphabet: (brackets show the 1/2 tones)




Continue plectrum study on the above exercise, grouping the notes in two, three and four notes per beat.



This musical diagram depeicts the string relationships. The numbers are the fret locations.


Study carefully if you have not already become aware of these relationships.
