Dispersed Voiced 3rd Inversion Chords Series 2. (bass note on "A" string)

6th to 7th and altered 5ths

D6 **D7** **D7b5** **D7+5**

Some might wish to add the doubled 5th.

Fingering would need to be modified when adding the doubled "b7th."
