## **Substitute Chord Arpeggios**

It may seem that I am in love with the eighth note triplet. In a happy-swing, it seems to be what I am drawn to but check out Lesson 13c for a new variation on this theme.

Any likely substitute triad or for that matter a four note chord can become a source of new improv material. Once again, I made an effort to have the original tune imbeded in this rhythmic and melodic variation on the favourite song.

## With a gentle swing



The modified arpeggios begin to lend a bit of mystery to the tune. More distant arpeggiating might disguise the tune even to the point of absurdity.

With each chord only having a two beat duration, the flamboyance of the arpeggio is restricted to how fast a mere mortal can play. Virtuoso super hero guitarists or for that matter any other world saviour musicians, may be able to stuff more notes into two beats.
