Moderate Waltz Tempo

"Variation on a Theme" (may be somewhat challenging)

"Rallentando" = slow down gradually ---- often abbreviated as simply "rall."

Another musical term which means much the same thing is "ritardando". (abbreviated as "rit.")

These terms should not be confused with "ritenuto" (abbreviated as "riten.") This word means to slow down immediately.
