



What is a possible problem with reverse integration?

A: may lead to the marginalization of disabled people should non-disabled people take over their domain



What are some issues with the "separation" approach toward disability and sport?

A: Normalizes exclusion and separation of disabled people within society; Assumes that mainstream providers not responsible for providing opportunities for disabled people; follows medical model



Why is integration sometimes not enough?
