## Data Recording Assignment

Weight: 20% of final grade Scored out of 52 marks

## Goal of the Activity

To provide the student with the opportunity to identify a behaviour for observation and data collection, write an operational definition and collect data. *Please ensure that you maintain client confidentiality.* 

#### Instructions

## **Create Operational Definition**

In discussion with your on-site supervisor, identify a behaviour for which you could collect data. Write an operational definition for the behaviour. Identify which dimension of the behaviour you will be measuring (e.g., frequency, duration, latency etc).

#### Collect Data

Establish a period to collect data (e.g., an entire day, a specific period of time, specific subject etc.). Your assignment must have a minimum of 7 data points. Submit raw data.

## Create a Graph

Using Microsoft Excel, graph your data, ensuring all of the conventions of an ABA graph are included(e.g., title, labelled x and y axis, black and white, phase lines, phases labeled, no horizontal/vertical lines etc.).

#### Reflection

In your assignment, answer the following reflection questions:

- 1. Was the dimension of behaviour recorded appropriate for the behaviour? Why or why not?
- 2. Was the recording system used appropriate for the behaviour? Why or why not?
- 3. Was your operational definition appropriate and accurate? Why or why not?
- 4. Identify one tool/technology/strategy that simplified data collection for you. If you did not employ one, suggest a technology/tool/strategy that could be useful.
- 5. Identify one challenge or barrier to collecting data. Provide a strategy or solution for addressing this challenge or barrier that is appropriate for the behaviour and the setting.
- 6. Identify a strategy for collecting IOA data that is appropriate for the behaviour and the setting.
